Protocol No.16 to the Convention (sharing of experiences, role of the Agents, interest to be invited at the October Seminar which will be organized by the Court): discussion in the light of a future assessment of Protocol No.16 to be made in the CDDH following the 99th CDDH meeting; Thematic committee for immigration cases (exchange of views): the Court has set up a thematic committee of three judges for immigration-related cases (Article 26 § 1 and Article 28 of the Convention, and Rule 27 of the Rules of Court). This is a transversal committee that will deal, for all the States Parties to the Convention, with cases on immigration matters falling within the Court's well-established case-law (Committee cases concerning expulsions, extraditions and related issues). This is the first such thematic committee to have been set up by the Court (the Court's press release: https://www.echr.coe.int/w/new-thematic-committee-for-immigration-related-cases); discussions concerning potential other such formats. Other questions: Follow-up on the discussion about permanent badges for Agents to access CoE premises.
